

# **FOOD SECURITY FUND**

Food security exists when all people at all times have physical and economic access to adequate amounts of nutritious, safe, and culturally appropriate food to maintain a healthy and active life.

## **OBJECTIVE OF THIS FUND**

The objective of this fund is to *support initiatives aiming to improve food security*, especially for individual or families in need, or people living on a low-income.

#### **ELIGIBLE INITIATIVES**

The initiatives eligible to this funding must aim to improve physical and economical access to nutritious foods (i.e improve availability or cost of food).

# For example, such initiatives could include:

Harvesting, food preparation & service of traditional meals at traditional camp Group or community harvesting activities (hunting, fishing, gathering berries)
Hunting services (e.g. for elders, single parent or low-income families) or Generous Hunters' Program¹
Community kitchen, collective kitchen², soup kitchen, group purchasing or Community Food Center³
Initiative to reduce wasting of food and to use surplus

Food sharing initiatives, including community freezers/refrigerators or community food pantry Collective or community gardens, community fruit trees & berry bushes Solidarity store, coop, local & affordable food market, community butchering service Food bank<sup>4</sup>, emergency food basket or food vouchers Meal programs or meals on wheels (e.g. for elders, people isolated or sick)

Collective grocery delivery service or transportation service to closest grocery store

## **ELIGIBLE ORGANIZATIONS**

- Non-profit and community organizations
- Cooperatives and social economy enterprises
- Aboriginal organizations eligible for provincial funding (e.g. Cree Nation Band Councils)
- Citizen initiatives that meet the objectives may be funded through an eligible trustee

<u>Note</u>: Para-public organizations (such as schools & school board, childcare services & health and social services) are not eligible to this funding but could be partners involved in the implementation of these initiatives.

#### **FUNDING AVAILABLE**

- A total amount of 100,000\$ per year is available for Eeyou Istchee
  - A maximum of 25% of this fund will be available for Emergency Food Aid
  - Most of the fund will be allocated for initiatives aiming to address determinants of food security (75% or more)
- A maximum of 10,000\$ will be allocated per initiative
- More than one initiative per organization could be funded

#### **ADMISSIBLE EXPENSES**

 Fees directly related to the initiative (e.g. foods, equipment, transportation, salary or honorarium, childcare service during activity)

<u>Note:</u> fees that are not directly related to the initiative or spending incurred before the beginning of the initiative are not eligible

## **CALL FOR PROPOSAL**

The deadline to submit a request is November 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2019 (See Funding Application)

## **SELECTION PROCESS/CRITERIA**

- A committee will review projects submitted
- Priority will be given to initiatives that:
  - Aim to address social, environmental & economic determinants of food security
     (e.g. initiatives aiming to make food affordable, easily accessible, culturally appropriate)
  - Have potential medium/long-term impacts (e.g. programs rather than one-time event)
  - Encourage social participation (e.g. volunteering, creating work opportunities for people on social income or with disabilities, etc.)
  - Aim to reduce poverty and social exclusion (e.g. socially and culturally inclusive)
  - Aim to provide healthy foods (rather than unhealthy/processed foods)
- Applicants of the selected initiatives will be informed in the weeks following the end of the call for proposal

# REPORTING

Selected applicants will need to provide a report at the end of the year (See Reporting Template)
