all within a context of a strong national Eeyou government which exercises complete jurisdiction and control over the delivery of quality comprehensive, integrated, inter agency health and social services, promotes Cree human resource development and applies adequate resources to address our needs with a strong expression of the Cree values of respect, honesty, loving, caring and sharing.

So declared on February 18, 1999 at the Special General Assembly held in Ouje-Bougoumou.
